NGE attorneys Brian Crump, Alex Dominguez and Peter Miles published an article in *Bloomberg Law* titled "DEA's Marijuana Rescheduling Move Would Trim Business Penalties." The article discusses how the DEA's proposed reclassification of marijuana from Schedule I to Schedule III could benefit the marijuana industry by reducing civil and criminal penalties and offering tax advantages. However, it would not fully legalize marijuana at the federal level.
