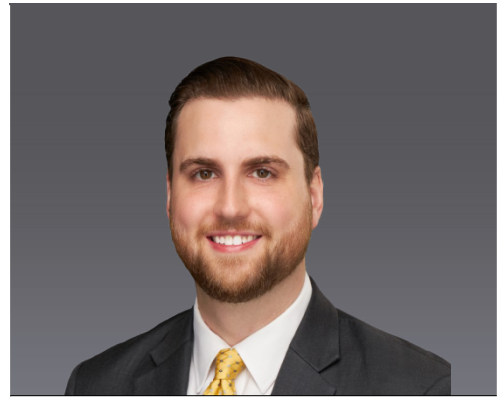
OVERVIEW
